Outline:

1. You will need to find a partner.
2. Ask your partner the following questions and record their answers.
3. Have your partner ask you the questions (they will record your answers).
4. After both of you have answered the questions, read the answers back to your partner. Make sure everything that was said is correctly recorded.
5. Prepare a short presentation about your partner encompassing all of the questions.
6. You will orally present your information to the class later today.
7. **Please Note:** This is a marked assignment so show respect during presentations.

Questions to ask your partner:

1. What is your full name?
2. How old are you?
3. When and where were you born?
4. Do you have any brothers or sisters? If yes, tell me about them.
5. Do you like animals? Do you have any pets? Describe them.
6. Do you have any hobbies? What do you do in your spare time?
7. Describe an embarrassing or funny story you have.
8. What does Social Studies mean to you?
9. What does democracy mean to you? Be detailed.
